Precautions for Site Placement

This machine is an indoor product and must not be placed outdoors. When placed indoorsAvoid the following:

- 1. Wet place.
- 2. Direct sunlight.
- 3. Around flammable and highly volatile liquids, drugs and dangerous substances.
- 4. Inclined plane.
- 5. Block emergency exits, fire extinguishers and other fire-fighting equipment.
- 6. Places with severe vibration.
- 7. Places with large dust.

Precautions for Operation

When placing, inspecting and repairing this machine, the owner shall ensure the player's personal safety and safetyTo avoid damage to the machine, please pay attention to the following:

- 1. Be sure to turn off the power during operation to avoid electric shockor short circuit accident.
- 2. Please do not pull out or insert the plug instantly to avoid electricshock or short circuit accident.
- 3. Please do not touch the plug with wet hands to avoid electricshock.






Error Code Quick List

ERROR	EXPLAIN	Release method
E1 Reset Motor	LED 11 LED 12	 Check whether the motor is stuck or idling due to loose screws. Restart the machine after removing foreign matters or reinforcing screws. Check whether the sockets at both ends of No. 2 reset motor are loose, turn the motor shaft to other angles, restart, and observe whether the motor rotates. Test and confirm with another good motor wiring. If the motor is broken, contact the manufacturer for replacement. Restart the machine after troubleshooting. the machine after trou- bleshooting. Check whether the wire sockets at both ends of the reset optical eye 11 / 12 are loose.
		2. Clean the dust and foreign matters on the optical eye, slide close to the optical eye with hard paper, and observe whether the optical eye indicator light flashes.




How To Play



- 1. Token input






Mainboard Wiring Diagram
